Seminole Trail assists on another late night fire

February 14, 2007

Units responding to Buffalo Ridge Road:

- E41, T49, E45, E84, E82, T69, E61, T57

At 2248 hrs. on evening of Thursday February 13, 2007, Seminole Trail Volunteers were dispatched to a structure fire reported near Buffalo River Road and Durrett Ridge Road in northern Albemarle County. First due units from Station 4 arrived to find a storage building fully involved with multiple exposures. Response times for all units were lengthened due to a major winter storm dumping sleet and freezing rain over much of the area. E84 remained in staging as E82 crew assisted with fire attack, while Chief's 80 and 83 assisted at the command post. Along with nursing from tankers, E41 established a water source from a nearby pool with the turbo draft and supplied to hand lines as well as a blitz fire 3" attack line. E84 and E61 were placed in service as the other units remained to extinguish the fire. The incident was marked clear at 0130 hrs.
